Per Order of the Supreme Court of Tennessee, the Clerk and Master's Office (Chancery Court), is OPEN and will remain open to the public for filings and to carry on the business of the court as usual subject to the provisions of the Tennessee Supreme Court Order.

In-person service is being limited at this time to protect employees and the residents of this county.

The Tennessee Supreme Court has issued an Order continuing suspension of in-person court proceedings and extension of deadlines. This Order is effective through April 30, 2020. Additionally, Chancellor John Rambo for the 1st Judicial District has entered a Standing Order pertaining to how cases are to be docketed during this period of suspension. If you should have an emergency or need an Order of Protection please let the bailiff at the courthouse entrance know and you will be escorted to the Clerk and Master's Office for assistance.
