This job is a Section 3 eligible job opportunity. Applications are encouraged from individuals that are low income and/or live in Public Housing and/or receive a Section 8 voucher.

Construction Laborer / Carpenter Job Summary

We are currently seeking Construction Laborers / Carpenters to join our team. You will collaborate with the project manager and building team to construct, install, and repair structures and fixtures made of wood, plywood, wallboard, and laminate. Structures include building frameworks, partitions, door and window frames, wooden stairways, rafters, and flooring. You must be able to work with raw and finish materials, and have a good working knowledge of standard industry tools and equipment. Many of our projects run through nights and weekends, so a flexible schedule is required.

Construction Laborer / Carpenter Duties and Responsibilities

- Read/interpret blueprints, drawings, and sketches and to understand project specifications
- Take measurements, calculate the sizes and amounts of materials needed for the project
- Cut, shape, and smooth lumber and other material (e.g. fiberglass) according to measurements
- Build window frames, doors, staircases, brattices, frame buildings, and other structures by using raw materials or pre-constructed items
- Install hardwood floors, siding, cabinets, drywall, and insulation
- Inspect products and conduct repairs or maintenance as needed
- Comply with all company and governmental safety guidelines

Carpenter Requirements and Qualifications

- High school diploma or equivalent
- 2+ years of professional carpentry experience a plus
- Working knowledge of carpentry techniques and methods, including installation and construction
- Proficient in using electrical and hand tools as well as measurement tools
- Able to read and interpret blueprints and technical drawings
- Good physical condition, stamina, and dexterity
