AGENDA: To present the proposed LPRF Grant Project, gather public input, and secure community support.

1 Project Breakdown:

- a) Local Parks and Recreation Fund (LPRF) Grant is a Tennessee state-funded 75/25 county match.
- b) Donation of the land can be used toward the county's match.

<u>Funding Source</u>	<u>Amount</u>
LPRF Grant (Cash)	\$2,250,000
Matching Funds (Cash)	\$325,000
Total Cash Available for Project	\$2,575,000
Matching Funds (In-Kind, land donation)	\$425,000
Total Project Value	\$3,000,000

As you can see, assuming a land value of \$425,000, this would require a cash match of \$325,000 and result in \$2,575,000 available for the project. We would apply to the GO Fund for the \$325,000.
