The Clerk and Master for Johnson County is Sherrie Fenner. She is the court official for the Chancery and Probate Courts who is the principal administrative aide providing assistance in the areas of courtroom administration and records management, docket maintenance, revenue management, maintenance of court minutes, official communications and various other court-associated duties. The office of the Clerk and Master was established by the Constitution of the State of Tennessee. Sherrie Fenner, Clerk and Master, was appointed in 2013 to her position and is currently serving under Chancellor John C. Rambo, 1st Judicial District of the State of Tennessee.

Types of civil cases handled by the Chancery and Probate Courts include: Divorce, Adoption, Paternity, Legitimation, Surrenders, Orders of Protection, Child Support Enforcement, Conservatorships, Guardianships, Real Estate Matters, Partition Suits, Name Change, Contract/Debt Suits, Specific Performance, Trusts, Contempt Matters, Minor Settlements, Appeals from Administrative Hearings, Foreign Judgments and Letters of Agreement of County Officials. The Clerk and Master also serves as Clerk of the Probate Court for the administration of wills and estates. The Chancery Court also collects delinquent property taxes for Johnson County and the Town of Mountain City.
